

Lesmurdie Primary School Voluntary Contributions & Charges 2024 Kindy - Year 6

Dear Parents/Caregiver

The Lesmurdie Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2024. The total amount of contributions parents/caregivers are being asked to pay has been set at \$60.00 per student which is in line with the School Education Regulations 2000.

The School Board would like to point out the contribution per child (\$60.00) equates to \$1.50 per week over the course of the year. The estimated costs provided are at the **upper limit** and the total amount requested next year will not exceed the amount shown.

We also point out that all contributions are used for the direct benefit of the children. Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in the Curriculum Learning areas.

While the contributions are voluntary the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution to the cost of supplementing funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth Governments. The table below gives you the breakdown of where we will direct your Voluntary Contributions.
